Exrei acquire business and operations of Medical Intelligence

Exrei Oy/Ab of Finland acquire assets and IPR of Medical Intelligence Technologies Inc. to bring together Columba, Vega and Urgentys GPS bracelets with the Everon GPRS based social care alarm system.

Oy Exrei Ab has acquired the assets and IPR of the Canadian Corporation Medical Intelligence Technologies Inc's. The acquisition provides a springboard for the rapid international expansion of the Finnish care and security system company Exrei and their mobile Everon system. Exrei intend to work with existing partners as well as customers of Medical Intelligence and its subsidiaries Medical Mobile in France, Spain and the United Kingdom to provide both continuity of service and a rapidly expanded product range.

Commenting on the acquisition, Markus Merne, CEO of Exrei said "Medical Intelligence has been a leader in personal telehealth and lone worker protection markets, integrating advanced mobile telecom and GPS technologies into the healthcare and security markets. They have developed market leading solutions such as the Vega GPS bracelet for people suffering from Alzheimer's and the Urgentys, the most feature rich lone worker solution currently available. Our aim is to capitalize on this experience and integrate these solutions into our existing Everon product range. Using Medical Intelligence's GPS experience, we will be able to provide the first complete solution that meets users' needs both indoors and outdoors in their daily lives. We will also be taking on the key R & D and Sales personnel of Medical Intelligence to provide continuity to customers initially in United Kingdom, France, Finland, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg and Spain where Medical Intelligence has operated to date but then in other countries as opportunities present themselves.

Mark Johnson, who formerly headed up Medical Intelligence in Europe, joins as a Director of Business Development. "I am delighted that this acquisition has finally taken place. Exrei are a perfect partner for our technology as their skills and experience are totally complementary. The potential of the new products are huge as they address not only the issues of tracking and locating vulnerable people but also, using the Everon system, provide a method for bypassing the potential problems of 21CN for the social care alarm market. In addition, the change in ownership will allow us to distribute our healthcare products to a much wider market as we are no longer tied to any exclusive distribution arrangements for the Vega bracelet".
